Publications of international organizations are also included in this definition. Examples of publications useful for First Peoples studies include treaties, laws and policies. Most recent government publications can be found online (see [research guide](#) for selected links), but the Library has an extensive collection of publications from the Government of Canada going back to the beginning of the country.
