This guide lists a selection of the more important sources for locating information on Child Studies at Concordia Libraries. It includes **Online** sources, print sources held in the Webster Library (**WEB**) on the Sir George Williams Downtown Campus, and print sources in the Vanier Library (**VAN**) on the Loyola Campus. The right hand column lists the call number and library locations for print sources and the publisher for online sources. Child Studies Databases

The databases listed below are used to find journal articles, research reports, books and book chapters, conference papers, and theses on education and related topics.

ERIC

The **major source** for child studies research; covers scholarly journals, research reports, books and book chapters, conference papers, etc.

PsycINFO

Another **major source** for child studies research; international coverage of journals, book chapters, and dissertations in Psychology and related fields;

Education Full Text

Fulltext coverage of scholarly and trade journals relevant to child studies.

Academic Search Complete

A multi disciplinary database, it indexes a large number of Education, Psychology, and Sociology journals. Fulltext coverage varies from journal to journal.

CBCA Education

Focuses on Canadian information; coverage of over 130 journals, including 24 fulltext.

ProQuest Dissertations and Theses – Full Text

Search over one million North American doctoral dissertations and masters theses; the majority of theses and dissertations from **1997 onward** are available fulltext

Sociological Abstracts

Covers international research literature on social aspects of education.

Web of Science

Features citation searching (cited author/cited work, etc.) of over 1,700 social science journals.
