## *Databases*

---

Databases are used to find references to journal articles and other types of documents (book chapters, conference papers, theses, etc.).

### [Academic Search Complete](#)

Multi-disciplinary database which indexes a large number of Education journals. Fulltext coverage varies from journal to journal.

### [CBCA Education](#)

Focuses on Canadian information; coverage of over 130 journals, including 24 fulltext.

### [ERIC](#)

The **major index** for Education research; covers journal articles, research reports, conference papers, etc.

### [ProQuest Dissertations and Theses – Full Text](#)

Search over one million North American doctoral dissertations and masters theses; the majority of theses and dissertations from **1997 onward** are available fulltext.

### [PsycINFO](#)

Contains international coverage of journals, book chapters, and dissertations in Psychology and related fields; a useful complement to ERIC; updated weekly.

### [Sociological Abstracts](#)

Covers international research literature on various social aspects of education.

### [Source OECD](#)

Useful for comparative education, providing international perspectives on education issues.

### [Web of Science](#)

Features citation searching (cited author/cited work, etc.) of over 1,700 social science journals.
